The organising team have worked hard to provide you with a no-nonsense event on the classic lanes on the maps 116

To enable us to keep the lanes for future use, we rely on you to help us by closely adhering to instructions in the route information regarding: - Quiets, Black Spots, Non-Comps and Caution Boards.

Your start number is as per the attached entry list. It has been compiled from the information given on your entry form, so the organisers will not enter into any discussion on their decision.

AMENDMENTS AND ADDITIONS TO SR'S

ASR16. D.S.O.'s

The appointed D.S.O's are: - Terry Wilson, John Leckie, Gareth Clarke & Brynmor Pierce

R18.6.3 Brakes are free but must comply with Construction and Use Regulations. A hydraulic handbrake is permitted where a functioning mechanical system is also present. The hydraulic handbrake lever shall operate in an arc not exceeding 50 degrees from the horizontal.

ASR19. Damage

The Damage Declaration will be at the bottom of the final timecard, and all competitors must complete it. Upon retirement, please email the meeting secretary a statement detailing whether you have been involved in any damage caused to your route or third-party property.

Failure to return a form may result in a fine of up to £100 and the competitor being reported to MOTORSPORT UK.

Competitors' cars will be inspected for damage in accordance with R15.1.4.

If you have been involved in an incident that has caused third-party damage, this must be detailed within the Damage Declaration to help with any post-event PR Work.

Accidents

Once again, competitors are reminded that, in accordance with section 170 of the Road Traffic Act 1988 and Rule 286 of the Highway Code, any incidents involving injury shall be reported to the police authorities. Competitors will be expected to contribute towards any costs or claims incurred with respect to the damage they caused. The condition of signing the entry form and Motorsport UK signing on forms at the start is that competitors accept this clause.

28. Retirement

Competitors are reminded that the competition numbers must be removed at the point of retirement, disqualification, or damage. This rule will be strictly enforced, and anyone failing to comply may be reported to Motorsport UK.

2. Noise & Scrutineering Control

Please see the start venue plan for the Noise and Scrutineering location.

Noise & Scrutineering will take place between 17.30 and 19:30

No individual times are set for visiting Noise Control & Scrutineering. Please arrive early to ensure that you have completed before 19:30.

Noise Check -

- This will be a 2 Meter noise test with a max 86dba limit.
- Please ensure you collect your Process Card at Noise Check.
- Once you have left noise, please make sure you have updated your process card with any areas highlighted.

Scrutineering -

- Please ensure you have your vehicle's logbook and M.O.T. certificate for the presentation.
- Please remember your spill kits.
- All tyres, including spares, will be checked at scrutineering for compliance with E-marked tyres.R.18.6.3
- Hydraulic Handbrakes must comply with Construction and Use Regulations. A Hydraulic handbrake is
 permitted but must incorporate the existing manufacturer's handbrake lever, mounting position and
 pivot point.

Any vehicle presented for scrutineering that does not comply with the Road Traffic Act, General Regulations section C, and Technical Regulations will not be allowed to start and will not be refunded their entry fee.

Motorsport UK-affiliated person will carry out Scrutineering and Noise Checks.

3. Signing On

Marshal & Competitor Signing On will be undercover at Fun Ship Market.

Food is available at the Funs Ship Market, but this is CASH ONLY

Signing On is open from 17.15 to 20.30

Your Process Card will be issued at Noise Check. You must successfully sign it at Noise, Scrutineering, and Marshal Signing On before attending Competitor Signing On.

Documentation

If you have not already done so, please upload all documentation and complete signing on via the entries system by Thursday, August 29th, at 18:00. You will not be able to make changes after this time.

At signing on, we will ask you to sign the official Motorsport UK signing-on sheet. You will need to check that your licence number matches the document.

Please ensure you have plenty of time to sign on if you have not already signed on electronically. Competitors must sign on by 20:45 hrs, and if they have not done so, they may be refused a start.

Map Marking Inspection

Maps 116 - Marking of the Map as per Motorsport U.K. Yearbook and stamping of Map Only highlight grid squares and basic start information are permitted. You will be asked to remove any other information & this may be checked at the start.

Club Membership Cards

If you still need an RDMC club membership and wish to apply on the night, payment will be in Cash ONLY.

Rally Licence Check

You will have to show your RS Clubman Licence or greater status licence

Parental Consent

Competitors Under 18 years MUST have completed a parental consent form. The Form is available from the Event Home Page RDMC website https://www.rhyldmc.co.uk/home

Outstanding Payments

Any outstanding payments must be Cash Only.

Rally Packs

Rally Packs will be issued after the successful completion of Signing On

Rally Packs will include: - Rally Plates, Timecards, PR Sensitive Areas defined by Black Spots / Quiets, N.A.M. Triangles, Allow passage letters and any other relevant information relating to the event.

Breakfast tickets will be issued when you return to MC3 In. Hand in your Final Timecard and complete the damage declaration on your timecard

<u>Please ensure you have written in your competitor number in all event documentation.</u>

4. Drivers Briefing

It will be held at 21.15 near signing on, and all competitors MUST attend this briefing.

5. Route Handout Information

This will be issued at MC 0 by Signing On at 22:18 for car 0 and then at 1-minute intervals according to your start number. A crew member must produce timecard 1 for signature.

Competitors are reminded to keep all route information private from anyone who is not a competitor. If proven you have divulged route, you may be disqualified at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.

6. Marshals

Marshals are essential to running the event, and we ask your marshal to understand where they are going and what they are doing.

Please ensure they have a map, as only a small amount of information is provided to get them to the control. Please also ask them to Download the free **What3words app** to help them get to their control.

If the marshal who has signed on for a competitor does not turn up at their control, leaves the control area before the arrival of the Closing Car, or is reported for driving in a manner likely to bring the sport into disrepute, the associated competitor may be disqualified from the results.

The Chief Marshal / Timekeeper will issue marshals who are allocated time controls with an official clock.

Once finished, the clock must be handed to the Closing Car or a Club Official. If any clock goes missing or is damaged, the associated competitor is responsible for replacing or repairing it.

Map 116 Hi-Viz Jacket Vest or Tabard
A hammer to knock in your Control Board

A A4 Clip Board
Warm and Wet weather clothing

7. Petrol Prior to Event

Shell Holywell Service Station - E5 available MR 116 – 190 750.5

Petrol will be available approx. 75 miles into the route (please note petrol grade E5 is available at this station.

8. Controls

All recordings by competitors must be in ink. Code Boards must be signed for at the following manned control (this does not include D.S.O. points or secret checks)

- MC Main Time Control.
- SS Standard Section Start
- SF Standard Section Finish
- T.C. Time Control
- PC Passage Control (should there be insufficient marshals, then the control will be identified with a code board and becomes known as a Route Check).
- RC Route Check.

A DSO board will indicate the presence of an official, and competitors are reminded they MUST STOP when requested, or Exclusion may apply.

PLEASE NOTE

PR work before the event has identified some locations where local residents have requested that disturbances be minimised. Competitors MUST heed quiet zones along the route.


There is no reason or excuse not to pay attention to these requirements; any crew not complying with them will be DISQUALIFIED. DSOs will be present at these locations.

In an emergency, the event has a dedicated mobile phone number: 07900 536713. The Secretary of the Meeting will carry this out throughout the night. The number is also repeated on all your timecards. Should you be unlucky to have to retire, please text your car number, the last control visited, and the reason for retirement.
